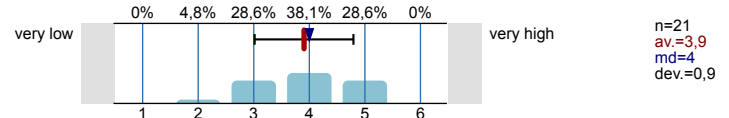

To what extent do you consider the seminar to be helpful for the fulfilment of your personal goals?

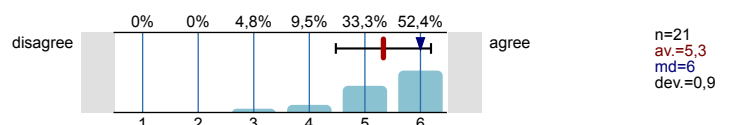


How high do you rate the overall level of difficulty in this seminar?

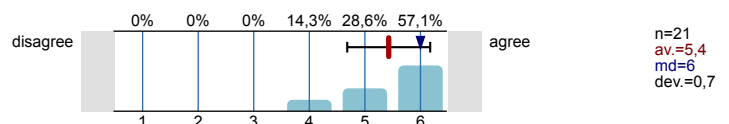

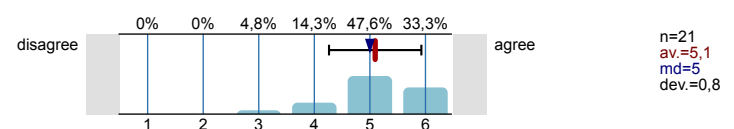

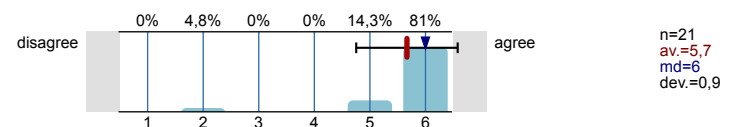

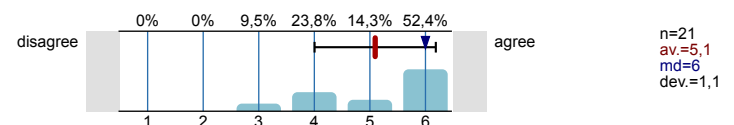

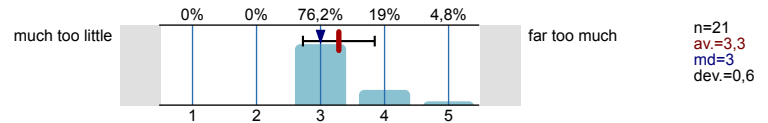

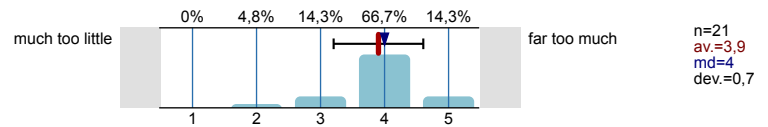

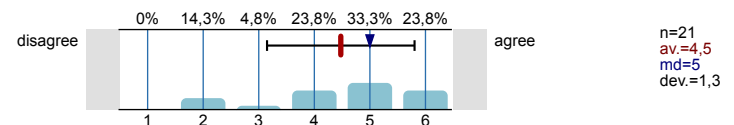

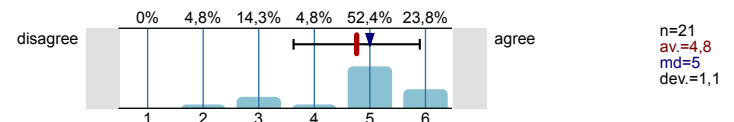

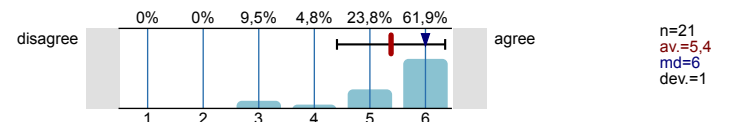

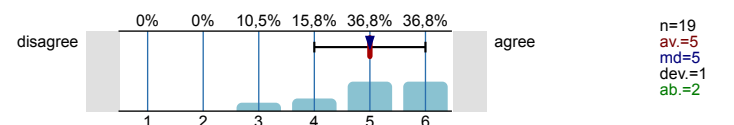

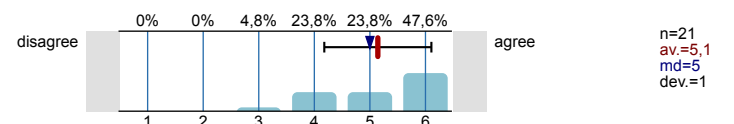

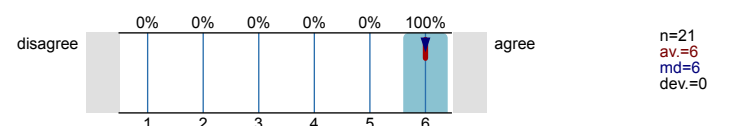

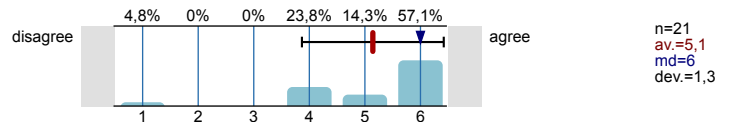

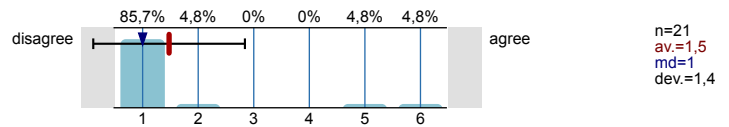

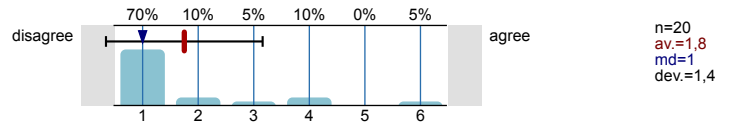

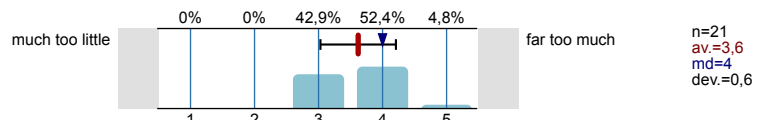


Are there time overlaps between this seminar and courses of others modules in this semester?

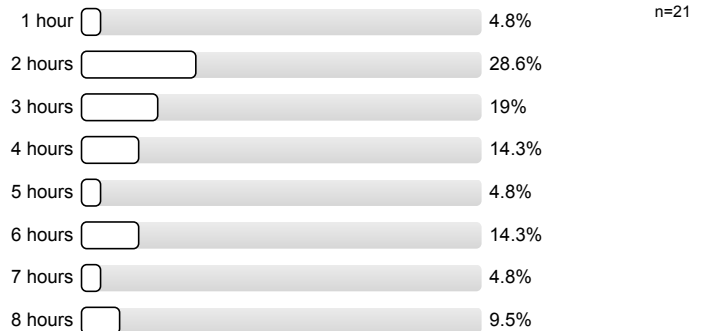

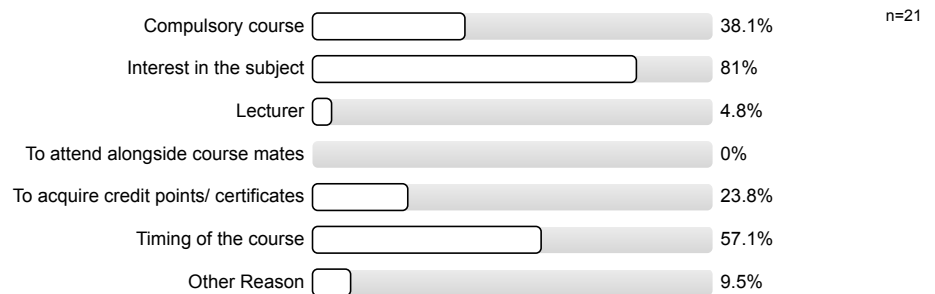

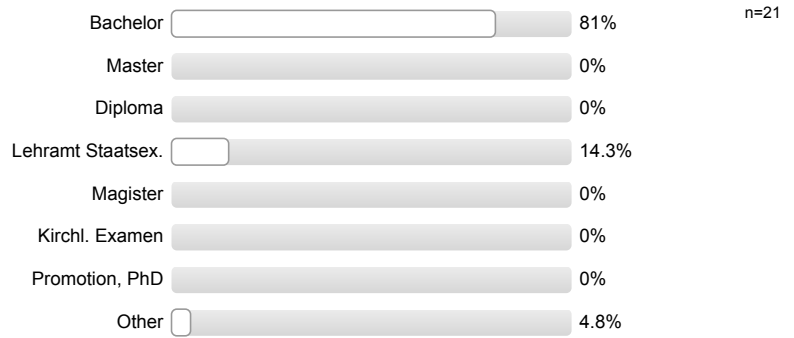

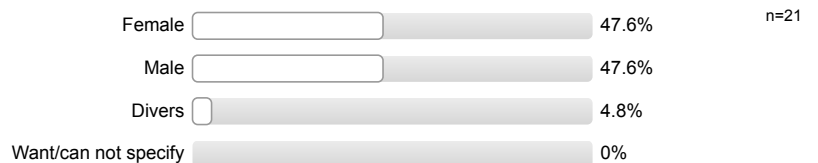

- I'll don't find that the Textwork in groups is productive. I like a well prepared presentation from the lecturer better, which can then be discussed. Often the students are not prepared or not able to handle the topics in a productive way. I didn't learn very much about a topic that was explained to me by another student.
I would like one good text, a well prepared presentation and then a fruitful discussion. And maybe some less topics and therefore more in-depth lectures.
- I do not fully understand why the seminar is held in english, because the lecturer is German and it doesnt rly make sense to me why it is held in english if the main lecture is in german anyway.
- Less reading material. It was far too much. Over 80 pages for a seminar are way too much. Either searching for more compact texts or try to find medias where the topics are more interesting presented. I can understand the intention behind the texts and the literature itself has a high value (f.e. when researching for term papers), but as simple preparations for a seminar, they are insufficient.
- the speed of the sessions was a bit too high as well as the talking speed of the lecturer.
