To what extent do you consider the seminar to be helpful for the fulfilment of your personal goals?




How high do you rate the overall level of difficulty in this seminar?
































Are there time overlaps between this seminar and courses of other modules in this semester?





Do you have any other comments about the seminar that you would like to share with the lecturer?

- - interesting course in which I learned a lot about a topic and different conflicts, that were really new to me; it was always clear what the lecturer is expecting from the students that was really nice
 - I would have wished for more interaction in class, I appreciate the group works that were taking place every session but the discussion with the whole class always felt a bit short. There was not really motivation to start a discussion in the course and even if, it was ended quickly. In my view more real discussion on the TJ measures (not only evaluating the pros and cons in a padlet) would have helped to develop ones own position regarding the measures which in turn helps to write the final assignment. Also I think the sessions would have been more interesting and livelier.
 - I think it could be considered if this course has to be taught necessarily in English - of course it is nice to make the course accessible for international students, which I encourage but it was obvious that both the students and also the lecturer feel more comfortable in German. This made discussions sometimes more difficult than necessary and the niveau of discussion was not the same as it could have been in German.
 - Until now, I dont quite get why we had to choose the Minor/Major for the seminar so early in the semester. It was helpful and much appreciated that we knew from the beginning what is expected but I dont understand what the benefits were that we chose our examination so early.
- Ich denke, dass es interessant wäre, weiter über die ‚klassischen Beispiele‘ von TJ hinauszugehen und die Anwendung dieser Perspektive auf aktuelle Konflikte zumindest beispielhaft zu beleuchten, gerade auch mit Hinblick auf die Major bzw. Minorassignments.
Die Vorbereitung auf die Prüfungsleistungen hätte ich mit etwas ausführlicher und expliziter gewünscht.
Außerdem denke ich, dass es sinnvoll wäre bei den Präsentationen von Anfang an zu ermöglichen, dass Studierende auch in Kleingruppen diese halten können.
Generell fand ich das Seminar aber sehr gut strukturiert und mir scheint es, als würde man einen guten Überblick über das Forschungsfeld bekommen.
- I have the feeling that the concept of Transitional Justice is clear by now. Therefore, I would be happy if more alternative conflict resolution methods would be introduced.

But overall it's a very nice seminar and it's a pity that the attendance is quite low...

- It often felt like school. Making a summary of a text as a poster doesn't encourage discussion and one doesn't learn much by doing it. Would have appreciated more discussion - potentially in smaller groups when students don't say much in the big group.

Structure of the course (first the methods, then examples) was great!
